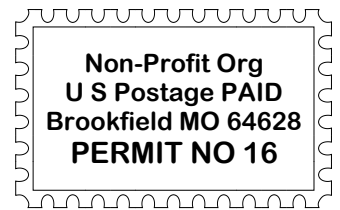

It has been said that vision without action is a daydream, and that action without vision is a nightmare. We have a vision here at Park Baptist Church and we need to make sure that all of our action accomplishes that vision. Our vision as a congregation is that we are ***committed to spiritual maturity, ministry, and missions.***

As we are in the early part of a new year, I want to challenge you personally to get involved in obtaining the vision for yourself and this congregation. We all need to understand that church is not something you come to and sit through passively. Church is the action of worshipping God and it must take place every day. Worshipping God is accomplished anytime you are actively seeking to bring Him glory. That happens in worship services when we are singing praises to God. It is also accomplished when God is honored by our service to Him. The true Church is every believer doing their part for the Kingdom of God.

Romans 12:1 says: “I beg you, therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.” The word used for ‘service’ can also be the word ‘worship.’ When you are serving God with the intent of honoring Him you are worshipping Him. Where and how are you currently serving?

As a part of the Body of Christ, Park Baptist Church prayerfully was led to the understanding that God wanted our vision to be that of being ***committed to spiritual maturity, ministry, and missions.*** The Vision Team of Park Baptist Church has been entrusted with the responsibility to guide that vision into a reality. The Vision Team is comprised of the areas of: Prayer, Discipleship, Evangelism, Worship, Fellowship, Ministry, and Administration. Every action and activity that we do falls under one or more of these areas. Every action and activity must also qualify itself as meeting the vision statement for this congregation.

We as individuals and as a church body exist for one reason and one reason only--to bring honor and glory to Jesus Christ! We must be committed to spiritual maturity, ministry, and missions in our own lives before we can be effective in spiritual maturity, ministry, and missions in the life of this church. Decide right now that you are going to commit yourself to service for God.

We have many current opportunities for service where God is at work. We are called to join God in what He is doing. Prayerfully choose one of the areas of service that comprise the vision ministry and get involved. Remember the goal is not to just be busy. The vision is spiritual growth that leads to ministry and missions.

As followers of Jesus Christ we must daily be participating in a personal relationship with Him. Quality time spent in prayer, devotional time, and worship. From our own growing relationship (spiritual maturity), will come ministry. Ministry is service to others. 1 John 3:18 states “*My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth.*” The love of Christ is the outflowing of our relationship with Him (ministry). From that outflowing will come a sincere concern for the lost and the spiritual insight as to how to best communicate Christ (missions).

God has blessed us by inviting us to serve. It is our privilege and our responsibility. Join today in serving (worshipping) our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! Commit to spiritual maturity, ministry, and missions.

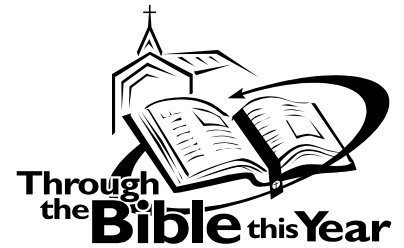
